
ITINERARY FOR VISITING OUR PLACE, BARANAGAR, THE ABODE OF SPIRITUALITY


 Baranagar Math was the first monastery of the Ramakrishna Order. In 1886, after the mahasamadhi of Sri Ramakrishna, Swami Vivekananda and other disciples of Sri Ramakrishna decided to make a dilapidated house at Baranagar their new math.



2. Sri Ramakrishna Mahasamsan, where the mortal body of Sri Ramakrishna was cremated.



3. Cossipore Udyan Bati, Sri Ramakrishna's last sojourn.



4. Adi Chitteswari Durga Temple (1610 AD), where the wooden icon of the Mother Goddess with Vaishnava icons. Horse is installed as the carrier (*vahana*) of the Goddess instead of Lion.



5. Chitpur Sarvamangala Mandir, where Kali the Mother is worshipped.




6. Sri Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama School was established in 1912 by Yogindranath Tagore, a disciple of Swami Brahmananda, who was one of the direct disciples of Sri Ramakrishna.



7. Alambazar Math is the second monastery of the Ramakrishna Order established in February 1892, which remained the order's headquarters till February 1898, after which it was finally moved to Belur on the bank of the Ganges.




8. Dakshineswar Kali Temple, is a navaratna temple. Situated on the eastern bank of the Ganges, the presiding goddess of the temple is 'Bhavatarini', a manifestation of Kali the Mother. The temple was established in 1855 by Rani Rashmoni. The temple is blessed for its close association with Sri Ramakrishna, Ma Sarada Devi and Swami Vivekananda.



9. Adyapitha Temple, where the icons of Kali the Mother, Radha-Krishna and Sri Ramakrishna are worshipped together.



10. Baranagar Pathbari Ashrama: On his way to Puri, Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu was moving along the Ganges, till a reading of the *Bhagavata* entered his ears. He looked and found a crying man in his hut reading the text. Sri Chaitanya resided at the hut for three days, discussed philosophy with him, and rendered him the title of Sri Bhagavatacharya. The place boasts in keeping the wooden sandals of Chaitanya Mahaprabhu.



11. Mani Mandir is a glass-temple of Sri Sri Ramakrishna
Paramahamsa and Srimati Sarada Devi, established by Swami
Satyananda, a devout follower of Swami Abhedananda, who was one of
the sixteen direct disciples of Sri Ramakrishna.



12. Joy Mitra Kripamayee Kali Temple is a replica of Dakshineswara Temple, established by *zamindar* Joy Mitra.



13. Belur Math is the present-day headquarters of the Ramakrishna Math and Mission, founded by Swami Vivekananda. It is located on the west bank of the Ganges, Belur. The temple is notable for its architecture that syncretically fuses Christian, Islamic, Hindu and Buddhist elements as a symbol of communal harmony.
